Efficiency, commitment and quality of care at the service of Central Catalonia





The commitment to **state-of-the-art robotic surgery** continues, extending to more surgical specialties

The surgical block of Sant Joan de Déu has incorporated a new state-of-the-art robotic technology that provides greater precision and safety, and which, at the same time, is less invasive, which favors a faster patient recovery. It is the Hugo RAS from Medtronic. The first interventions with this new technology have been carried out by professionals from the General Surgery and Digestive System Service. The deployment has been progressive and has also included Urology and Gynecology. Althaia thus continues its commitment to the most advanced robotic surgery, which was first introduced in 2023.





Pilot test for **prostate cancer screening** within a European research project


The pilot test for prostate cancer screening has begun in the Althaia Basic Health Areas within the European research project PRAISE-U (PRostate cancer Awareness and Initiative for Screening in the EU). In one year, we'll ask more than 5,000 residents of Manresa and Sant Salvador de Guardiola aged 50 to 69 to have a blood test and, depending on the results, to undergo other tests. The aim is to detect prostate cancer early. Althaia is the only Catalan entity included in the research, which has the participation of 25 institutions in 12 countries.



Balil-Pelegrí Scholarship for research on breast cancer and cardiac toxicity

Clara Martínez Vila, assistant at the Oncology Service of Althaia and researcher at the IRIS-CC, is the winner of the third edition of the Balil-Pelegrí Scholarship for a research project on the early detection of cardiac toxicity generated by breast cancer treatments. Awarded by the GEICAM Breast Cancer Research Group, the Balil-Pelegrí Scholarship is a benchmark in medical research in Spain. The Evaluation Committee assessed the scientific interest, innovative approach and potential impact of the project on improving the treatment of patients with breast cancer.







International launch of a *pioneering training tool* to improve early detection of colorectal cancer

Althaia has begun the international rollout of the new training tool aimed at gastroenterologists and surgeons trained in colonoscopy from around the world. It is the *Training* platform in optical diagnosis of early colorectal cancer (TOD early CRC), an online tool that allows specialists to improve their skills in the optical diagnosis of early colorectal cancer, as well as to establish its treatment. Marketing began in Spain and in Latin America, and gradually began to spread to Europe and the rest of the world. The project is led by Ignasi Puig del Castillo, doctor at the Digestology Service of Althaia and coordinator of the GOES (Gastrointestinal Oncology, Endoscopy and Surgery research group.



Visit by the *Commissioner for Mental Health* of the Ministry of Health

The Commissioner for Mental Health of the Ministry of Health, Belén González, visited Althaia to learn first-hand about the community care model for mental health and addictions in Central Catalonia. She was shown the child and adolescent care programs that have been deployed in the region, with special emphasis on the Child and Adolescent Crisis Care Program, a new home-based care alternative focused on the person's natural environment, and the Comprehensive Approach Program for Highly Complex Mental Health Cases.



The *3rd International ISaMBeS Congress* addresses emerging challenges in mental health and emotional well-being

The 3rd International Congress on Innovation in Mental Health and Social Well-being (ISaMBeS) addressed emerging challenges in the fields of mental health and social well-being. The issues discussed included the use of new and potentially dangerous recreational drugs and the increase in self-harm in adolescents and young people, as well as the role of advanced technologies and art in treatments. The organization was under the auspices of the ISaMBeS research group, Althaia, the Hospital Consortium of Vic, Osonament and the Chair of Mental Health of the UVic-UCC .










Althaia participates in the creation of a **new model of integrated social and health care** for people with dependency

The City Council of Manresa, the Althaia Foundation, the Catalan Health Institute and Sant Andreu Salut, with the collaboration of U Manresa and the Departments of Health and Social Rights of the Generalitat de Catalunya, are developing a project of integrated social and health care. It is the SISS Manresa model (Integrated Health and Social Services), which is aimed at people with chronic illnesses who have a high level of dependency and care needs, from both social and health services, and who receive all this support at home. It is a pioneering project, chosen by the Generalitat de Catalunya, which will allow the deployment of a new model of integrated social and health care in the capital of Bages.





Technological transformation and networking, themes of the 8th Althaia Conference

Around 500 professionals from the Althaia Foundation have participated in the institution's 8th Conference, an event to share knowledge, experiences and future projects. Under the motto "We innovate to advance", this year's edition has once again highlighted the involvement of healthcare professionals in continuing to promote projects that allow the application of new work methodologies, promote research and improve the quality of care. During the Conference, a total of 45 papers were presented, including oral communications and videos, which were grouped into three main themes: networking, the transformation of the institution -both technological and methodological- and future projects. 

A group of Althaia psychologists and the best chefs in Catalonia published a unique book that unites emotions and cooking recipes. In two years, more than *600 cancer patients* treated at Althaia have benefited from precision oncology

Althaia fully applies precision oncology in the care of patients with cancer. This represents an important step forward in addressing this disease and an unprecedented advance in its diagnosis, treatment and prognosis. In two and a half years, 633 patients have been studied through precision oncology, which focuses on genetic alterations found in the DNA of the tumor. Although precision oncology has been part of the Catalan Health System's service portfolio since 2021, at Althaia this approach has a history of more than 15 years.



New communication tool between Althaia and Primary Care professionals


Primary care professionals from the Hospital Sant Joan de Déu and the Central Hospital (Centre Hospitalari) can contact directly with the Primary Care reference professionals in the region through a new, recently launched communication tool called Bidirectional Interconsultations. This is an application that, through both integration with the IS3 platform of CatSalut and the joint work between the Althaia Foundation and the Catalan Institute of Health (ICS), allows personnel from the Medical Work Station (ETM) to enter the consultation, which reaches the Primary Care professional through the Primary Care Clinical Station (ECAP) as if it were a telematic visit, all of which facilitates continuity of care.



The Wi-Fi system of Althaia *centers is renewed* to improve coverage and security

Althaia has renewed the Wi-Fi system of its different centers, an action that allows the institution to have a more robust and secure technological infrastructure, and, at the same time, to enjoy better coverage. After carrying out a study of needs and coverage, simulations were performed to analyze which were the best locations and the best devices to use. The process consisted of switching all devices to Wi-Fi 6, a more advanced technology, and relocating some of the access points to optimize network performance. All of this has improved performance and allows the Wi-Fi network to continue growing in the future, with the aim of offering a better service to both healthcare professionals and patients and families.
