

Annex 2_ Conditions of the training stay

In any of these cases that will now be detailed, the professional in training must always be **duly identified** as a "professional in training" by carrying in a visible place the **card that is given to them by the Althaia Teaching Unit** .

NATIONAL PROFESSIONAL TRAINING STAYS IN ACTIVE

Practical training

- The professional in training is **NOT** authorized to access the HIS or the patients' **clinical history**.
- The professional in training You will only be able **to consult a clinical history** if you have the **patient's express consent** (verbally) and this must **always be done in front of the healthcare professional who supervises** the training stay.
- **YES** they will be able to **actively participate in welfare events** , as long as these **conditions are met** :
 - The professional in training will have to be **supervised directly** at all times by an Althaia professional
 - **The patient's express consent** (verbally) must be obtained so that the professional in training can **be present at the care event**.
 - **The patient's express consent** (verbally) must be obtained so that the professional in training can **actively participate in the care act** .
 - In both cases, since consents will be given orally, it will be necessary **to leave it in writing in the clinical course** .

NATIONAL PROFESSIONAL TRAINING STAYS NOT IN ACTIVE

Observational training

- The professional in training is **NOT** authorized to access the HIS or the patients' **clinical history**.
- The professional in training You will only be able **to consult a clinical history** if you have the **patient's express consent** (verbally) and this must **always be done in front of the healthcare professional who supervises** the training stay.
- The professional in training will **NOT** be able to **actively participate** in any **healthcare event** (he will only be able to act as an **observer**).
- **The patient's express consent** (verbally) must be obtained so that the professional in training can **be present at the care event**.
- Since consent will be given orally, it will need **to be written down in the clinical course** .

TRAINING STAYS OF LESS THAN 3 MONTHS

Observational training

- The professional in training is **NOT** authorized to access the HIS or the patients' **clinical history**.
- The professional in training You will only be able **to consult a clinical history** if you have the **patient's express consent** (verbally) and this must **always be done in front of the healthcare professional who supervises** the training stay.
- The professional in training will **NOT** be able to **actively participate** in any **healthcare event** (they will only be able to act as an **observer**).
- **The patient's express consent** (verbally) must be obtained so that the professional in training can **be present at the care event**.
- Since consent will be given orally, it will need **to be written down in the clinical course** .

NATIONAL TRAINING STAYS BETWEEN 3 AND 6 MONTHS AUTHORIZED BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH

Professionals who will NOT be registered in Spain (observational training)

- The professional in training is **NOT** authorized to access the HIS or the patients' **clinical history**.
- The professional in training You will only be able **to consult a clinical history** if you have the **patient's express consent** (verbally) and this must **always be done in front of the healthcare professional who supervises** the training stay.
- The professional in training will **NOT** be able to **actively participate** in any **healthcare event** (they will only be able to act as an **observer**).
- **The patient's express consent** (verbally) must be obtained so that the professional in training can **be present at the care event**.
- Since consent will be given orally, it will need **to be written down in the clinical course** .

Professionals who will be registered in Spain (practical training)

- The professional in training is **NOT** authorized to access the HIS or the patients' **clinical history**.
- The professional in training You will only be able **to consult a clinical history** if you have the **patient's express consent** (verbally) and this must **always be done in front of the healthcare professional who supervises** the training stay.
- **YES** they will be able to **actively participate in welfare events** , as long as these **conditions are met** :
 - The professional in training will have to be **supervised directly** at all times by an Althaia professional
 - **The patient's express consent** (verbally) must be obtained so that the professional in training can **be present at the care event**.
 - **The patient's express consent** (verbally) must be obtained so that the professional in training can **actively participate in the care act** .

- In both cases, since consents will be given orally, it will be necessary **to leave it in writing in the clinical course** .
